



The EEG surcharges have been in place since 2000.

They were removed from household electricity bills from July 01, 2022.

→ Since then, all taxpayers in Germany have been paying the Energy and Climate Fund (EKF) of the federal government to pay the EEG surcharge with a total of 18.489 billion euros (2024).

This corresponds to **50.6 million euros per calendar day!**

* "Transfer" of the EEG levy from July 01, 2022

Only an apparent relief for the electricity user!

Increases the profits of electricity suppliers and grid operators.

In the period 2021–2022, the costs for "procurement and distribution" increased 3-fold!
