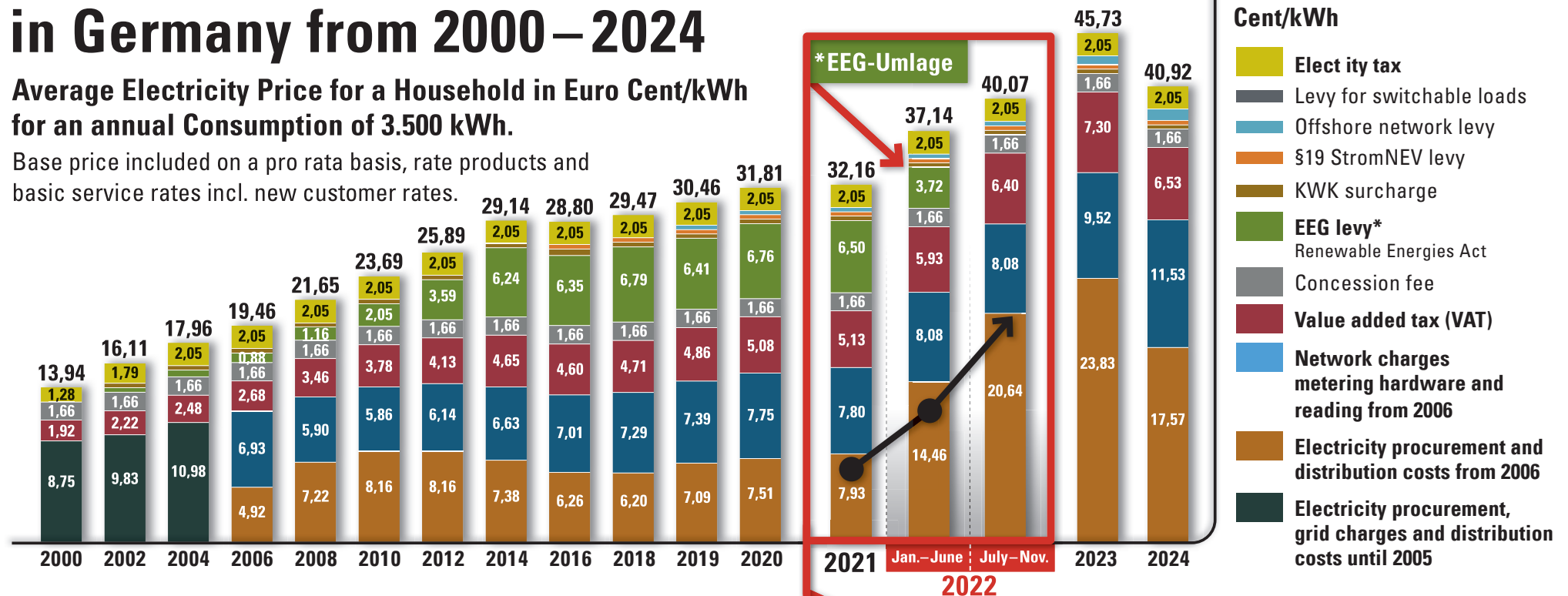


Development of Household Electricity Prices in Germany from 2000 – 2024

Average Electricity Price for a Household in Euro Cent/kWh for an annual Consumption of 3.500 kWh.

Base price included on a pro rata basis, rate products and basic service rates incl. new customer rates.



- **The EEG surcharges** have been in place since 2000. They were **removed from household electricity bills** from **July 01, 2022**.
- Since then, all taxpayers in Germany have been paying the **Energy and Climate Fund (EKF)** of the federal government to pay the EEG surcharge with a total of **18.489 billion euros** (2024) .
- This corresponds to **50.6 million euros per calendar day!**

*** "Transfer" of the EEG levy from July 01, 2022**

Only an apparent relief for the electricity user!
Increases the profits of electricity suppliers and grid operators.

In the period 2021–2022, the costs for "procurement and distribution" increased 3-fold!
